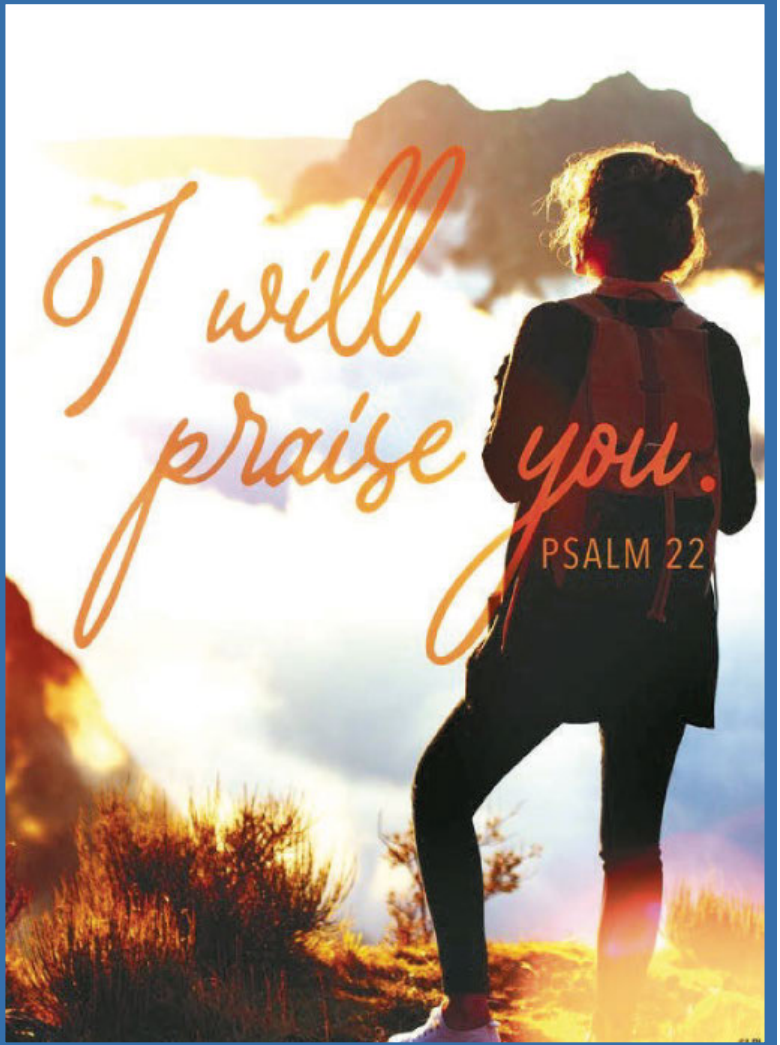
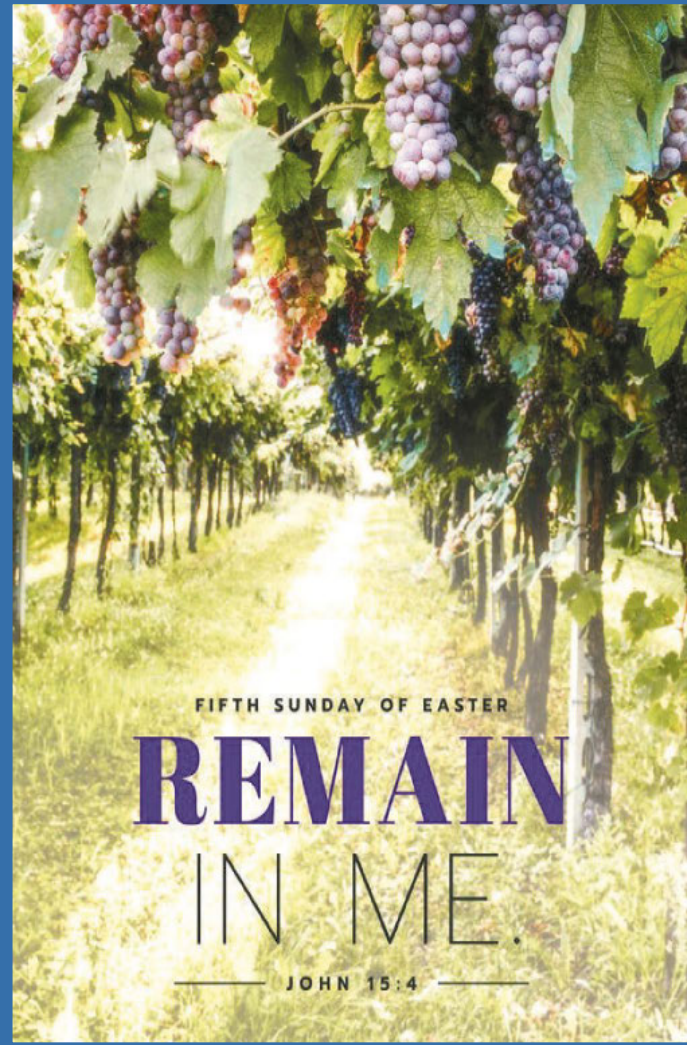

Sacraments and Prayer

Eucharistic Adoration: Fridays: Begins after 9am Mass and ends at 10:30am.

Baptism: During pregnancy, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for a special blessing of the child in the womb. Soon after birth, call the secretary to arrange an interview with a staff member and details on STARTING POINT, our parent enrichment program.

Confession / Reconciliation: Confessions will be heard on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm, or by appointment with one of the priests.

Marriage: Soon after engagement, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for the special blessing of an engaged couple. Call the secretary at least six months prior to the desired wedding date to begin BETTER TOGETHER, our couple's enrichment program.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the rectory to arrange for a priest to celebrate this sacrament due to serious illness, a planned medical procedure, or advanced age.

Communion of the Sick: The clergy and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion attend to the homebound sick. Please call Jane at 718-762-2252 or the secretary to arrange temporary or long-term coverage.

From the Pastor's Desk....



Dear Parishioners,

I think of our rectangular block of parish property as my estate. It gives me great pleasure to walk the estate through the seasons to admire what's blooming and to identify what needs work. I save most of the work for Ramon and Francis but I can't help getting soil under my fingernails, if only to weed or pick up litter. I take pride in the dozens of new trees and bushes planted in my time, mourn the mature trees felled by storms, harbor some regret over those removed for parking lots, and get impatient for replacement street trees from the city—seven at the moment. I panicked momentarily when I thought the white dogwood planted by the Macchio's for my 40th anniversary last May was dead. I gave it another week, thinking about how I would replace it in the dead of night, and suddenly it burst forth in bloom. I'm afraid one of the two pink dogwoods planted about five years ago in front of church will not be as lucky. It has struggled since the beginning. For a city block we are fortunate that only one third is covered with buildings, one third paved, and a full third is green. My real pride and joy is an apple tree planted from seed by Mrs. Molloy's nursery class many years ago. Presented to me at graduation when it was about two inches tall, I planted it behind the rectory after scouting the property for an ideal spot. It only has about three feet of space between fence and sidewalk but I figured I could prune it to grow the opposite directions. For years it hardly grew at all and I was asked several times if it should be pulled up, but I knew it was growing underground, developing a healthy root system. This spring it has shot up over eight feet tall and is bearing blossoms for the first time. Can fruit be bar behind? Well, maybe. I've always harbored some doubts about our hybrid, genetically modified fruits, whether they can still bear progeny from their seeds. We will see, but Sister Donna just spoke to me from the other side of the fence, and noted how strangely the tree was growing, branching out only to the north and south. That was always my intention, I replied, but never realized that God is my gardener, doing the necessary pruning to bear fruit. You may be wondering about how I am going to conclude this homily with no space left. I don't have to, the deacons are preaching for me this weekend. Just look over the Sunday Gospel and rejoice that we can bear good fruit as long as we remain attached to the Lord.

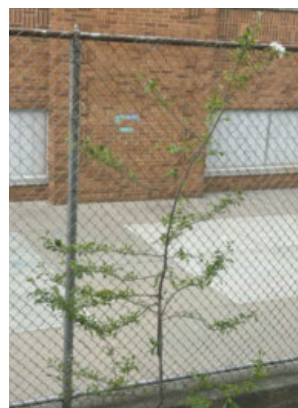
MOTHER'S DAY

Religious Education stopped being called CCD, Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, around the late 20th century. CCD was a Catholic term for teaching kids about religion if they didn't go to Catholic school. But as time went on, other churches started similar programs, so calling it CCD wasn't really applicable anymore. "Religious Education" became the new way to talk about it because it covers teaching about all kinds of religions, not just one. The term evolved to become more inclusive and to cover more ground in teaching about faith. While CCD might have been the old terminology, Religious Education is the new and improved title!
