# **Sacraments and Prayer**

Eucharistic Adoration: Fridays: Begins after 9am Mass and ends at 10:30am.

Baptism: During pregnancy, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for a special blessing of the child in the womb. Soon after birth, call the secretary to arrange an interview with a staff member and details on STARTING POINT, our parent enrichment program.

Confession / Reconciliation: Confessions will be heard on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm, or by appointment with one of the priests.

**Marriage:** Soon after engagement, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for the special blessing of an engaged couple. Call the secretary at least six months prior to the desired wedding date to begin BETTER

TOGETHER, our couple's enrichment program.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the rectory to arrange for a priest to celebrate this sacrament due to serious illness, a planned medical procedure, or advanced age. Communion of the Sick: The clergy and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion attend to the homebound sick. Please call Jane at 718-762-2252 or the secretary to arrange temporary or long-term coverage.

Dear Parishioners.

For many Catholics questions

frequently arise about death and dying and our understanding of the afterlife. How are we to think about our loved ones who have gone to their "eternal rest". Since November is coming up, the time we traditionally pray for the dead and consider our own mortality, I have asked our Adult Faith Formation Team to host a wonderful new resource from the Augustine Institute called Eternal Rest: The Art of Dying Well. While we may ponder such questions, we rarely discuss them. This will be a great opportunity to further clarify and explore all the topics around the issue of death. After all, to die well means to live well. This weekend's scriptures remind us that God is preparing a great feast for us and sending out the invitations. Whether we get to enjoy it depends on our response. Let's get our "wedding garments" ready! (See the bulletin about these four sessions; Team members can help you sign up this weekend.)
