From the Pastor's Desk....

Dear Parishioners.

The month of November is traditionally a time of remembrance when the Catholic community prays for those who have died. We began this week with the festival of all the saints, followed by the commemoration of all the faithful departed. Parishioners submitted hundreds of names to be remembered at those Masses and throughout the month. The Book of the Dead which rests at the Marian Altar, a necrology by date of death, has been updated to list all those whose funerals were celebrated here in the past year. Their next-of-kin have received an invitation to join us next Sunday at the noon Mass. The names will be read, and family members can place a candle at the altar to represent them. Following the Mass we will bless the new memorial bricks that have been requested in the Memorial Rosary Garden. Our four-part series called Eternal Rest- The Art of Dying Well, has begun; it's not too late to join us on Thursday evenings at 7pm in the Parish Center. The weeks of November are the final weeks of the church's liturgical year and our focus in the scriptures turns to end times as we renew our great hope that our earthly end is a transition into a new life in God's heavenly reality. Finally, on the Solemnity of Christ the King we celebrate he who is the alpha and the omega, the beginning and the end of all things and the one will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. Then a new year of grace begins in Advent once again.

During this short time, our First Grade class has gone for a tour of the Church and have been learning how to make the Sign of the Cross. Our Eighth Graders have signed their Confirmation covenant's, which is the first step towards receiving the Sacrament in March. We had a very successful fire drill, with the support of Mrs. Kane and the custodial staff, and were able to vacate the building in just over 2 minutes. Our Catechists are working hard each week to bring the faith to the children with innovative lessons and discussion. The enthusiasm between the students, catechists and helpers is evidence that the Holy Spirit is very active within our Religious Ed. family. It is a blessing and privilege to be a part of this ministry.




