
Annual Catholic Appeal 2024 Prayer





Dear Parishioners,

"Repent and believe in the gospel." The words we heard when ashes were imposed on our foreheads, we hear again in the Gospel of the First Sunday of Lent. We have begun our journey of 40 days. As I write on Ash Wednesday, the sun is shining in my window and through a glass trophy award I received years ago, displaying on my ceiling all the colors of the rainbow. (I snapped a photo in case you don't believe me.) And I open to Sunday's first reading from Genesis that says God will set a rainbow in the heavens as a sign of his fidelity to the new covenant he makes with Noah and every living -creature for all ages. 
