





## **Sacraments and Prayer**

**Eucharistic Adoration: Fridays**: Begins after 9am Mass and ends at 10:30am.

Baptism: During pregnancy, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for a special blessing of the child in the womb. Soon after birth, call the secretary to arrange an interview with a staff member and details on STARTING POINT, our parent enrichment program.

Confession / Reconciliation: Confessions will be heard on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm, or by appointment with one of the priests.

**Marriage:** Soon after engagement, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for the special blessing of an engaged couple. Call the secretary at least six months prior to the desired wedding date to begin BETTER

TOGETHER, our couple's enrichment program.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the rectory to arrange for a priest to celebrate this sacrament due to serious illness, a planned medical procedure, or advanced age. Communion of the Sick: The clergy and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion attend to the homebound sick. Please call Jane at 718-762-2252 or the secretary to arrange temporary or long-term coverage.

## From the Pastor's Desk....

Dear Parishioners,

We are reminded on the Third Sunday of Lent to follow the commands of the Lord for they save us from our own foolishness and give life. The cleansing of the temple by Jesus may also serve as a reminder that divine grace and not our own efforts is what cleanses our soul and makes us a dwelling place pleasing to God. Let us be reconciled to God through Christ.

Congratulations to our 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls' basketball team who won the Diocesan Championship last weekend; go Blue Lightening!

With gratitude I share with you this good news: the parish has received a very generous bequest from the estate of the late Peggy Driscoll. Please remember her and all our benefactors in your prayers.

The Diocesan Eucharistic Revival event that was postponed due to rain has been rescheduled for Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup> at the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center in Flushing Meadows-Corona Park. 50 tickets will be available to us and more information will be forthcoming.

In preparation for Easter the parish commissioned three new altar frontals in white silk damask and gold bandings. They will adorn the main altar, tabernacle, and Blessed Mother Shrine for Easter and its 50-day season and other solemnities and feasts which call for white or gold. If a donor would like to offer one to the parish as a memorial gift, please contact Fr. Bob. The cost for the main altar is \$1,500 and for the smaller side altars, \$1,200 each. Labels can be attached, and memorials are permanently listed in the front of the Parish Necrology Book at Mary's Shrine.
